It appears to match up very closely.

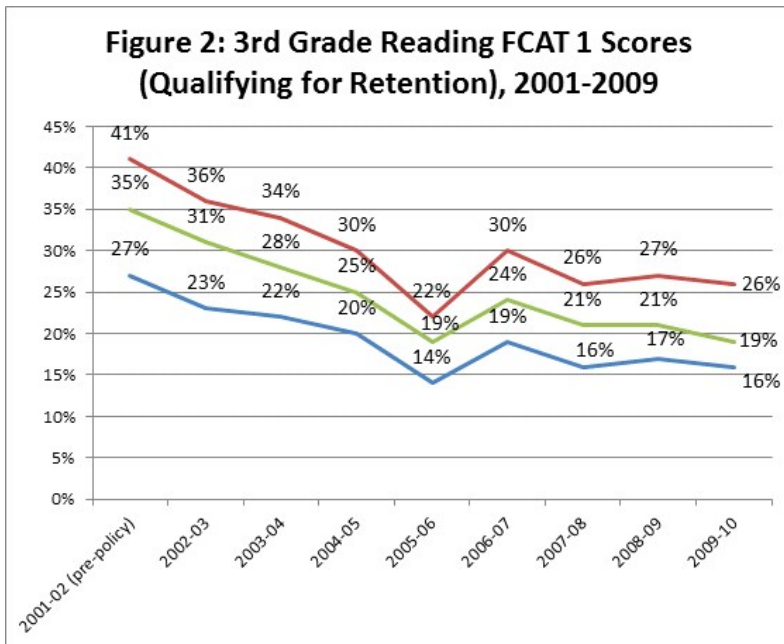
