Regarding the dropout spreadsheet, can we add the following:

- The percent of PROMOTED Level 1 third grade students that dropped out of school (display same grades as retainees who dropped out - 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>)
- Add the following:
  - Of the Level 1 third grade students RETAINED, what percent are still in the Florida school system, and of that percent, what percent are in 11<sup>th</sup> grade VS
  - Of the Level 1 third grade students PROMOTED, what percent are still in the Florida school system, and of that percent, what percent are in 12<sup>th</sup> grade

\*Also, please include number of students (#) with all percent's (%).
