Thank you all for your time and work assisting us with the elementary civics module edit. We simply could not have done this without you!

Based on the work completed by the committees, the edited versions of Grades K, 1, 3, and 4 are now on the website: <http://floridacitizen.org/elemcurriculum/>. We still consider this website to be in draft form and ask that you please do not share the link with your teachers until we have it in a final format. (We anticipate that the website will be in a final format in mid-October. I will email the entire committee when the website is live.)

My hope is that Grade 2 will be added to the website by the end of this week. We are still in the process of editing Grade 5 and anticipate having those modules ready for distribution by November 1st.

We plan to send the final K-4 modules to print late next week. I have tried to edit the modules as accurately as possible based on the committee notes but would love for you all to take a look at the edited modules and send me any feedback or suggestions. In order to meet the print deadline, please send any feedback to me by Wednesday, September 28th. You can either email me your comments as email text or download the module, track your changes in the document and email it back to me.

Please keep in mind that we will add the finalized "Instructions for conducting a Read Aloud" text and text about the Common Core Standards before the modules go to print. Also, please note that I edited the clip art to match the committee suggestions when possible, however this was not always possible.
