Hi Stuart, as update MDRC had short calls yesterday with PAEC and NEFEC just to start understanding how the FFR part of the reading initiative was organized – and how eligible students were selected for FFR (from an RD design perspective). I spoke with Fred Doolittle again in the afternoon. He is very interested in exploring possibilities with FL DOE for expanding the scope of the study (from simply FFR) to include other interventions.
