I have this, but it's not based on retained students, rather grade 3 students that scored level 2, and their performance thereafter. But this may be what I need, but basing it off our first cohort of retained student (due to them scoring level 1 in 2002-2003, and serving their retained year in third grade in 2003-2004) VS. grade 3 students scoring Level 1 who were PROMOTED.

Basically replace level 2 with level 1 retained students, and replace Level 3 or above performance with level 2 or above performance.

I'm not sure how to find this out except to first find out what percent of the 2002-2003 student who scored level 1 and were retained (first cohort of retained students), are now in 11th grade. We might could see how they've scored on FCAT each year since. Like what percent of those retained, scored Level 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 each year after the retention. Just hoping you all may have this latter data already, but I'm pretty sure we don't have data to answer my first question.
