Subject: Third grade progression

Hey Kevin and Laurie,

I'm hoping you can assist. I believe the Department should have 2010-2011 third grade retention data available by now. Do you know where I can access it? I need the following:

- Of the percent of students that scored Level 1, what percent were retained? AND of those that scored Level 1 and promoted due to a good cause exemption, what percent qualified for each good cause exemption? See attached chart as an example, just need 2010-2011 added, percent of students for each numerical number listed, AND an additional row (right under total third grade enrollment) that represents 3rd grade students scoring Level 1.

Something else I would LOVE to see is the % of our first cohort of retained third graders that are still in school vs. the % of the students that scored level 1 but were promoted anyways (due to good cause exemptions, etc) that are still in school. Our first cohort of students that were retained were

identified in 2002-2003.

Is there any way to get this data?
